

## Home-Grown in Malvern Charges for September 2026



Outstanding since 2013

For non-funded children or for additional non-funded hours, the following rates apply:

### Hourly Rates

Hourly rate for 0-24 months	£10.50
Hourly rate for 2 year olds	£9.50
Hourly rate for 3 -4 year-olds attending term time only :	£8.50
Hourly rate for 3 -4 year-olds attending all year:	£8.00

### Funded Children

Parents wishing to use their **full funding entitlement of 30 hours** per week with us, may choose how to apportion those hours across the week as long as there is a minimum of 6 hours allocated each day. This will be fixed in your contract.

*Non attendance including sickness and holidays will be charged at the usual hourly/sessional rate.*

For parents in Receipt of Working Family Funding or Nursery Education Funding who **do not** want to allocate their full funding entitlement to Home-Grown (in the case of split settings or not requiring 30 hours childcare) the following sessional times apply:

**Full day: 7.45am – 5.30pm**

**Half day: 8.00am – 1.00pm or 12.30pm – 5.30pm**

**Please Note:** For **all half day** sessions there is an additional payable charge of **one hour** to give the minimum daily setting attendance of 6 hours.

All children in receipt of Working Family Funding or Nursery Funding will be requested to pay an Additional Integrated Services Charge (AIS) of £1.60 per hour for each of the *funded hours* attended. The minimum AIS charge for attendance is £9.60 per day (£1.60 x 6 hrs) for a term time only contract and £7.20 (£1.60 x 4.5) per day for an all year round contract.

The AIS charge covers costs which are not included in your Nursery Funding.

£1.00 per hour of the AIS charge covers a freshly prepared, healthy home-cooked lunch, plus a freshly prepared and healthy morning and afternoon snack. 60p per hour of the AIS charge helps to cover the cost of some consumables such as cooking ingredients and gardening resources.

If you are **not** in receipt of Funding, charges for the sessions are as follows:

#### **Babies aged 9 months to 2 years**

Full day £98.00  
Half day £62.00

#### **Children aged 2 – 3 years**

Full day £85.00  
Half day £55.00

#### **Children aged 3 – 4years**

Full day £75.00  
Half day £50.00

***Our minimum hourly charge is 6 hours over one day and would comprise one half day session plus 1 hour charged at the applicable hourly rate.***

If your child is eligible for Working Family Funding, you will need to apply within the **term before** they turn 9 months or 2 yrs respectively.

*Please Note – if your child is absent, charges still apply. Any extra hours booked in with us will be charged for if your child does not attend.*

### **Stretched Funding**

We also offer All Year Round care for children over 2 years at our Holiday Club. Funding can be stretched to cover costs across the year.

A 48 week stretched offer would be:

38 funded weeks x 30 hrs = 1140 hrs

$1140 \div 48 = 23.75$  per week

5 days @ 23.75 funded hours  $\div 5 = 4.5$  hrs per day

4 days @ 23.75 funded hours  $\div 4 = 5.5$  hrs per day

3 days @ 23.75 funded hours  $\div 3 = 7.5$  hrs per day

2 days @ 23.75 funded hours  $\div 2 = 10$  hrs per day

We may also be able to claim additional funded hours at the end of each term if there are any left in your account.

### **Wrap Around Care from the Wyche Primary School**

Before school club opens at 7.45am. After school club closes at 5.30pm

Breakfast Club £6.50 (£7.00 with breakfast)

After School (**up to 5.30**) £11.50 (and includes an afternoon tea comprising sandwiches and home-made cake.)

**Late charge** for collection after **5.30pm till 5.45pm** - £16.00

**Late charge** for collection after **5.45pm till 6.00pm** - £25.00

Daily rate (8.00am – 5.15pm) for over 8s (school holidays, TED days etc.) - £45.00\*

Daily rate (8.00am – 5.15pm) for 5 to 8 year olds - £48.00\*

\*Additional charge will apply for early drop offs or late collection

*Please Note – as above, if your child is absent, charges still apply. Any extra hours booked in with us will be charged for if your child does not attend.*
